PROPOSALS FOR GENERAL MANDATES TO ISSUE NEW SHARES AND REPURCHASE SHARES RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTORS AND NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

1. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this circular is to provide the Shareholders with, information in respect of the resolutions to be proposed at the Annual General Meeting, among others, for (i) the granting of the Issue Mandate to the Directors; (ii) the granting of the Repurchase Mandate to the Directors; and (iii) the re-election of retiring Directors.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

2. GENERAL MANDATES TO ISSUE NEW SHARES AND REPURCHASE SHARES

Ordinary resolutions will be proposed at the Annual General Meeting to approve the granting of general mandates to the Directors:

- (a) to allot, issue and deal with the Shares of up to 20% of the number of issued Shares of the Company as at the date of passing of such resolution (the "Issue Mandate");
- (b) to purchase the Shares on the Stock Exchange of up to 10% of the number of issued Shares of the Company as at the date of passing of such resolution (the "**Repurchase Mandate**"); and
- (c) to extend the Issue Mandate by an amount representing the number of Shares repurchased by the Company pursuant to and in accordance with the Repurchase Mandate.

The Issue Mandate and Repurchase Mandate will continue in force until the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company held after the Annual General Meeting or any earlier date as referred to in ordinary resolutions No. 4A and 4B set out in the notice of Annual General Meeting.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the number of issued Shares of the Company comprised 1,191,265,000 Shares.

Subject to the passing of the proposed resolution in respect of the granting of the Issue Mandate and on the basis that no further Shares are issued or repurchased prior to the Annual General Meeting, the Company would be allowed under the Issue Mandate to issue a maximum of 238,253,000 Shares (representing 20% of the Shares in issue as at the date of granting of the Issue Mandate).

An explanatory statement, as required by the Listing Rules to be given to Shareholders in connection with the Repurchase Mandate, is set out in Appendix I to this circular.

3. **RE-ELECTION OF RETIRING DIRECTORS**

In accordance with Article 87 of the articles of association of the Company, Mr. Tse Siu Sze and Dr. Lui Ming Wah shall retire from office by rotation and, being eligible, offer themselves for re-election at the Annual General Meeting. Dr. Lui has served as an Independent Non-executive Director of the Company for more than 9 years. During his years of appointment, Dr. Lui has demonstrated his ability to provide an independent view to the Company's matters. The Board is of the view that Dr. Lui is able to continue to fulfill his role as required and he is therefore considered as independent and should be re-elected.

Biographical details of the retiring Directors proposed to be re-elected at the Annual General Meeting are set out in Appendix II to this circular.

4. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The notice of the Annual General Meeting is set out on pages 11 to 15 of this circular. At the Annual General Meeting, resolutions will be proposed to approve, *inter alia*, the granting of the Issue Mandate, the Repurchase Mandate and the re-election of retiring Directors.

APPENDIX I

The following is an explanatory statement required under the Listing Rules to be sent to the Shareholders to enable them to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the ordinary resolution to be proposed at the Annual General Meeting in relation to the granting of the Repurchase Mandate.

1. SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the number of issued Shares of the Company comprised 1,191,265,000 Shares.

Subject to the passing of the proposed resolution in respect of the granting of the Repurchase Mandate and on the basis that no further Shares are issued or repurchased prior to the Annual General Meeting, the Company would be allowed under the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase a maximum of 119,126,500 Shares (representing 10% of the Shares in issue as at the date of granting of the Repurchase Mandate).

2. REASON FOR REPURCHASE OF SHARES

The Directors believe that the Repurchase Mandate is in the best interests of the Company and the Shareholders. Such repurchase may, depending on market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value and/or earnings per Share and will only be made when the Directors believe that such repurchase will benefit the Company and the Shareholders.

The Directors have no present intention to repurchase any Shares.

3. FUNDING OF REPURCHASES

In repurchasing Shares, the Company may only apply funds legally available for such purchase in accordance with the memorandum and articles of association of the Company, the Listing Rules and the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands. 6. IMPLICATIONS UNDER THE TAKEOVERS CODE

If on the exercise of the powers to repurchase Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, a Shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases, such increase will be treated as an acquisition for the purposes of Rule 32 of the Takeovers Code. As a result, a Shareholder or group of Shareholders acting in concert could obtain or consolidate control of the Company and become obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rules 26 of the Takeovers Code.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Girgio, being the controlling shareholder of the Company, held 770,980,000 Shares representing approximately 64.72% of the number of issued Shares of the Company. In the event that the Directors exercise in full the power to repurchase Shares in accordance with the Repurchase Mandate, assuming that the present shareholdings and capital structure of the Company remain the same, the interests of Girgio in the issued Shares would be increased to approximately 71.91% of the total number of issued Shares of the Company. The Directors are not aware of any consequences which would arise under the Takeovers Code as a result of exercising power under the Repurchase Mandate.

The Directors have no present intention to repurchase any Shares to the extent that it will trigger the obligations under the Takeovers Code to make a mandatory offer or which will result in the amount of Shares held by the public being reduced to less than 25% of the total issued shares of the Company.

7. SHARE REPURCHASE MADE BY THE COMPANY

No repurchase of Shares has been made by the Company during the six months immediately prior to the Latest Practicable Date (whether on the Stock Exchange or otherwise).

The biographical details of the Directors to be re-elected at the Annual General Meeting are set out below:

DETAILS OF RETIRING DIRECTORS

Mr. Tse Siu Sze, aged 52, is an Executive Director of the Company. Mr. Tse joined the Group in July 1990 and has served a number of positions in the Group. Mr. Tse was appointed as an Executive Director in December 2013. He is currently the general manager and a director of Zhongshan L.K. Machinery Co. Ltd. Mr. Tse has over 30 years of experience in production management, sales and marketing.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Mr. Tse had personal interest of 1,235,000 shares in the Company, representing approximately 0.10% of the issued share capital of the Company. Mr. Tse has entered into a service contract with the Company for a term of three years commencing on 1 December 2019. Mr. Tse receives total emoluments HK\$1,500,000 per annum and a discretionary bonus which will be determined with reference to individual performance and profit level of the Group for the year.

Dr. Lui Ming Wah, *SBS*, *JP*, aged 82, was appointed as an Independent Non-executive Director of the Company in September 2004. Dr. Lui is an established industrialist serving as the Honorary Chairman of The Hong Kong Electronic Industries Association Ltd. and the Honorary President of The Chinese Manufacturers' Association of Hong Kong, the founder chairman of Hong Kong Shandong Business Association and a member of The Hong Kong International Arbitration Center Advisory Council. He was elected to the First, Second and Third Legislative Council of the HKSAR in 1998, 2000 and 2004 respectively. Dr. Lui is also member of the tenth and eleventh National Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference. He is the managing director of Keystone Electronics Co., Limited. Besides, he is currently an independent non-executive director of AV Concept Holdings Limited and Gold Peak Industries (Holdings) Limited (both being listed companies on the Stock Exchange in Hong Kong) and Asian Citrus Holdings Limited (also listed on the London Stock Exchange). Dr. Lui obtained a master's degree in Applied Science from the University of New South Wales in Australia and a PhD from the University of Saskatchewan in Canada. He is a Fellow of The Hong Kong Institute of Directors.

Dr. Lui has entered into a service contract with the Company for a term of three years commencing on 4 September 2019. Dr. Lui is entitled to a director's fee of HK\$220,000 per annum and an additional fee of HK\$90,000 per annum for acting as chairman of the Remuneration Committee which is determined with reference to this duties and responsibilities.

Save as disclosed above, so far as the Directors are aware, as at the Latest Practicable Date, (i) none of the above two Directors has any interest (within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO) in the securities of the Company; (ii) none of the two retiring Directors holds, or in the past three years held, any directorship in any public company the securities of which are listed on any securities market in Hong Kong or overseas and other major appointments and

- 4. Completion and return of the form of proxy will not preclude a member from attending and voting in person at the Annual General Meeting. If such member attends the Annual General Meeting, however, his form of proxy will be deemed to have been revoked.
- 5. The register of members of the Company will be closed from Monday, 7 September 2020 to Thursday, 10 September 2020 (both dates inclusive) during which period no transfer of Shares will be registered, for the purpose of determining the identity of the shareholders entitled to attend and vote at the Annual General Meeting. In order to qualify for attendance at the Annual General Meeting, all properly completed transfer forms accompanied by the relevant share certificates must be lodged with the Company's Hong Kong branch share registrar and transfer office, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, Shops 1712–1716, 17th Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong not later than 4:30 p.m. on Friday, 4 September 2020.
- 6. The following precautionary measures will be taken by the Company for the Annual General Meeting to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 epidemic: (i) compulsory temperature checks; (ii) compulsory wearing of surgical face masks; (iii) compulsory sanitizing the hands before entering; (iv) social distancing; and (v) no provision of refreshments and/or souvenirs. Any person who does not comply with the precautionary measures may be denied entry into the Annual General Meeting venue. Shareholders are encouraged to appoint the chairman of the Annual General Meeting as their proxy to vote on the relevant resolutions at the Annual General Meeting as an alternative to attending the Annual General Meeting in person.
